



How To Deliver Your Master Content Files to KTWU

Producers,

We look forward to airing your content on KTWU. By now, you have arranged for licensing of your content for air on KTWU through our Programming Department. As mentioned during the program submission process, KTWU has technical specification requirements that must be met for successful delivery and air of your content. When delivering your content, please ensure:

-KTWU prefers file sizes of around 25 Mb/s. The max file size KTWU can accept is 50 Mb/s. If your file is larger than 50 Mb/s, please down-convert files to 25 Mb/s before delivering to KTWU.

-Frame Size: 16/9: 1920 x 1080

-Frame Rate: 29.97

-Video Standard: NTSC

-Scan Type: Interlaced (Upper Field First)

Audio Stream

-Codec: PCM (Little Endian)

-Number of Audio Channels: 2 (Stereo)

-Sampling Rate: 48 KHz Bit Depth: 16 bits

-9db peak

Closed-Captions (REQUIRED)

-Closed-Caption data must be encoded with CEA 708 and CEA 608 streams

Promos

-KTWU recommends the content be delivered with a :15, :20, or :30 video promo with the last :07 clear of narration and lower-thirds so we can tag with our own air-date information.
